

## **EMpower for Children**

### **(Scholarship Program for Youth)**

#### 1. Rationale

The Thai Credit Foundation recognizes the importance of promoting educational opportunities for underprivileged youth to reduce inequality and foster long-term development. This initiative aims to provide widespread support through public educational institutions under the Ministry of Education, ensuring continuous access to education and enhancing the quality of life for Thai youth.

#### 2. Objectives

To promote educational opportunities for financially disadvantaged youth in schools, with a focus on fair and widespread support.

#### 3. Target Institutions

Eligible schools must meet the following criteria:

- Be under the Ministry of Education.
- Provide primary or secondary education.
- Have a designated teacher responsible for selecting scholarship recipients who meet the eligibility criteria.

#### 4. Number of Supported Schools

A total of 10 schools will be supported.

## 5. Criteria and Implementation

### 5.1 Announcement of Applications

The Thai Credit Foundation will publicly announce the scholarship program to invite schools with financially disadvantaged students to participate.

### 5.2 School Selection

Selection will be based on the number of underprivileged students, with priority given to schools in remote or underserved areas.

### 5.3 Number of Scholarships

Each selected school will receive 10 scholarships, each worth 3,000 THB, totaling 30,000 THB per school. The designated teacher will select eligible students.

### 5.4 Required Documents

Schools must submit the following documents for nominated students:

- Copy of the student's ID card.
- Certification letter from the school.
- Academic records or other documents proving student status.

### 5.5 Fund Transfer and Follow-up

Once approved, the foundation will transfer funds to the school's account. The school will distribute the scholarships to students, who must sign a receipt. The school must also send back a signed receipt and a thank-you letter from the principal to the foundation.
